Karim's* search for God started online. But his journey really began before then, when he was serving a sentence in a Moroccan prison. While he was there, Islamic spiritual leaders visited him and gave him lectures about what a bad person he was. "There was little grace," he says, "only a wide chasm between me and the expectations of Islam." Their words seemed meaningless. He struggled with the rigidity and lack of compassion he saw in spiritual leaders and was longing for something different.

After he was released, Karim searched the internet for answers and, finding a media outreach website in his language, he filled out a simple contact form. To his surprise, a local believer named Elias* sent him a message the very same day.

Finding answers to his questions

Elias invited Karim to download a copy of the Bible on his phone and begin reading it. As he did, Elias was there to explain the parts he didn't understand. "I had so many questions," says Karim. "How can you say Christ is God? How can I become a Christian? What is the difference between Jews, Christians and Muslims?" After four months of messaging and studying online, he met Elias in person and they continued to meet for a further six months. Karim came to appreciate the grace and warmth he saw in Elias. It was a huge contrast to what he had experienced with spiritual leaders in the past. Then in 2021 Karim came to faith in Christ....

Vicar's Comment

Last Sunday (31st) I mentioned that because our service had fallen on New Year's Eve, there might be a sense in which we feel pulled in two directions. Firstly, backwards, because we were still in the Christmas season going by the calendar....but also forward because New Year's Eve points us towards 2024: a new year with new possibilities perhaps.

For most if not all of us, time seems to operate in 'chunks' of weeks or perhaps months...we exist in a bit of a matrix of multiple commitments and relationships that means we don't feel we can afford to think of nothing but today. And yet - today is worth thinking about. I read a book once which pointed out that God gives us time in little parcels called days: in Psalm 90:12 Moses prays 'Teach us to number our <u>days</u>, that we may gain a heart of wisdom' (NIV, emphasis mine). Not weeks, months or years, but days. My hope is that I am better at seeking God's wisdom and will in 2024 as I follow Jesus - I hope you aspire to that too.
